B. Preparing the design of a social project

Each year we choose a theme that reflects the prevailing mood of the country. Every participant gets an opportunity to think, reflect and arrive at realistic conclusions which thereupon can be actualized in his/her own small ways. The theme chosen for this year is *PRESERVING 'INDIANNESSE' IN A GLOBAL INDIA*.

Those wish to participate in the **TEEN OF THE YEAR 2009** should send us the design of a project (based on the theme of the event) that you will take up in your community and will make a difference to the society.

Your project should answer the following questions:

1. What is your project idea? (What do you want to do?)
2. Why do you want to do this? (What makes you passionate about it?)
3. What are the resources (in terms of money, team members, time frame to complete the project etc.) you would need to realize this project?
4. What is the expected outcome/impact of your project?

Guidelines:

1. Your project should not exceed more than one A4 page.
2. You can also present your project creatively through a design with written explanations.
3. Your project would be evaluated on the following basis: *Innovativeness of the project, its link with the theme, its reach and scope and its possible impact.*
4. Pay special attention to the fact that the project should clearly mirror the theme for the year.
5. While it is acceptable to have adult guidance and supervision in the project, **THE TEENAGER** wants it to be *BY* teens and *FOR* teens.
