SHARE YOUR VOICE, YOUR VIEW

- * Create an eye-catching project that can be replicated at different parts of India.
- * Plug in to your creativity!
- * Each teen is limited to one entry, so make it count!

TAILOR YOUR MESSAGE

- * The goal of your project is to be able to make a difference through an idea of change.

REACHING THE AUDIENCE

- * Judges will be looking for creativity and relevance of the project.
- * Take a look at your community, school, society; what is needed to happen for change; what catches your eye.
- * Teen projects are young and youthful. It is about doing something refreshingly different.

CREATING A WINNING PROJECT

Step One: Creating the Ideas

- * Brainstorm. Think teens, technology, society. What pulls these concepts together? Work on one idea that can be translated into an action that makes the difference.

Step Two: Designing the project

- * Create a couple of drafts and show them to your friends and ask them what they feel is most practical, interesting and possible.

Step Three: Practicality

- * Keep the design as simple as possible.
- * Be sure you have not used any copyrighted ideas or material.
- * Make sure your project follows the guidelines
